EASTER MESSAGE FROM BISHOP OF SANDHURST LESLIE TOMLINSON

Holy Week is term given to the very sacred time leading up to Easter. It is the week during which we recall the suffering and death of our Lord, Jesus Christ.

Jesus remained resolute, even in the face of persecution, torture and death, to the Mission He received from his Father; the Mission of proclaiming God's love for all people.
