Project "Food packages for people in need" Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of Saints Peter and Paul of Melbourne — Charitable Organization Patriarchal Foundation "Mudra Sprava" of the UGCC

The food packages project, supported by the Eparchy of Saints Peter and Paul of Melbourne, is one of the largest projects of the Patriarchal Foundation "Mudra Sprava" aimed to help temporarily displaced persons, refugees and people who have suffered the grave consequences of military aggression in a full-scale war of russian federation against Ukraine.

In February 2023, the Patriarchal Foundation "Mudra Sprava" received funds in the amount of \$168,520 USD to produce 10,750 food packages and deliver them to parishes, centres for temporarily displaced persons, refugees and people who have suffered from the war along the front line and in difficult regions of Ukraine.

In the process of implementing this food project, the Patriarchal Foundation "Mudra Sprava" involved a team of 25 people, 70% of whom are people who lost their jobs at the beginning of the war or are low-income. The funds received within this project were used to form food packages for 2 people for 1 week need and deliver these packages to parishes and communities of the UGCC that have suffered severe consequences of war and occupation.

Each food package consisted of 13 items of food products with a total weight of 8.5 kg:

It is worth mentioning, that from the beginning of its activities to the present day, the Patriarchal Foundation "Mudra Sprava" has managed to organize a coordinated process of its activities, starting with the production, purchase, storage, packaging and delivery of ready-made kits to those in need. This path was not easy, we had to overcome various obstacles, which were obviously related to the consequences of the enemy's full-scale invasion of our territory. However, the staff of the Patriarchal Foundation "Mudra Sprava", partners, people who helped and supported the Foundation in its intentions in every possible way, gradually adapted to all the challenges of the war and overcame all difficulties step by step.

As a result, in March 2023, 10 750 food packages were delivered to parishes and communities of the UGCC located in 5 regions of the North-Eastern, Central and Southern parts of Ukraine, namely, in:

- o Sumy (administrative centre of Sumy Oblast, North-Eastern Ukraine);
- o Kropyvnytskyi (administrative centre of Kirovohrad Oblast, Central Ukraine);
- Kherson (administrative centre of Kherson Oblast, Southern Ukraine) and Kherson Oblast (Beryslav);
- o Odesa (administrative centre of Odesa Oblast, Southern Ukraine) and Odesa Oblast (Yuzhne, Berezivka, Izmail, Ryasnopil);
- o Mykolaiv (the administrative centre of Mykolaiv Oblast, Southern Ukraine).

Thus, 10 parishes and communities of the UGCC were provided with food supply, uniting Ukrainians living in the occupied, de-occupied, and even in the territories where hostilities are still ongoing.

Thanks to this project, we were able to prevent at least 21,500 people from being left alone in the threat of hunger.
